

INTRODUCTION

- 1. This is Army Service Forces Quartermaster Supply Catalog, QM 3-1, List of Items for Troop Issue—Enlisted Men's Clothing and Equipment. It contains those standard items of Quartermaster male clothing and individual equipment the authority for requisition and issue of which is found in T/O 21, Clothing and Individual Equipment, Tables of Organization and Equipment, and ASF Catalog QM 4, Allowances of Expendable Supplies.
 - 2. Sections of the QM 3 series are as follows:
 - a. Qm 3-1, List of Items for Troop Issue, Enlisted Men's Clothing and Equipment.
 - b. QM 3-2, List of Items for Troop Issue, WACs' and Nurses' Clothing and Equipment.
 - c. QM 3-3, List of Items for Issue to Posts, Camps, and Stations.
 - d. QM 3-4, List of Items for Issue to Troops, Miscellaneous Organizational Equipment.
 - 3. Each section of the QM 3 series contains the following information:
 - a. Introduction, including any instructions necessary to the clarity of the text.
 - b. An alphabetical index.
 - c. Illustrations and descriptions of the principal items contained in the section.
- 4. Correct nomenclature, stock numbers, and expendability are given for each item in this section. Illustrations and descriptions are furnished so that those concerned may become familiar with the general appearance of the various items. Types and specifications will vary from time to time, therefore the illustrations cannot always be used for surveys, over, short, and damage reports, or for purposes of procurement. Neither are they necessarily in proportionate size, since it is sometimes expedient to clarify small items or to conserve space on large ones.
- 5. This section is subdivided into several groupings which are listed in the Contents. A complete index lists every individual item alphabetically, with the number of the page on which it appears.
- 6. A complete list of sizes is not given for many items in this catalog. In such cases the stock number indicates the coverage, for example, Shoes, Service, Stock No. 72-S-1811—72-S-2106-10. In writing requisitions, lower echelons should specify the particular sizes desired. Higher echelons, in consolidating these requisitions, should refer to ASF Quartermaster Supply Catalog, QM 5, "Stock List of All Items," and insert the proper stock numbers for the various sizes.
 - 7. Each expendable item is marked "X" in the Expendable column in accordance with AR 35-6620.
 - 8. Weight and specification number have been indicated where information was available.



SHOES, SERVICE, COMPOSITION SOLE Stock No. 72-S-2225-35-72-S-2248-65

This shoe is the same as the shoe, service, with the exception that there is an outside tap of reclaim rubber which gives at least twice the wear obtained from leather. The issue of this shoe is confined to the United States.

SHOES, SERVICE

Stock No. 72-S-1812-72-S-2106-10

A welt constructed shoe, blucher pattern, with $\frac{1}{2}$ bellows tongue, outside counter pocket, full toe vamp, toe cap (without box toe), heavy first quality bend outersole, slip tap, and reclaim rubber heel. The upper leather is best quality, heavy, Army Russet shade, side leather fully chromed and vegetable retanned. The shoe is unlined.

SHOES, SERVICE, HOB-NAIL

Stock No. 72-S-2266-36-72-S-2271-86

This shoe is made like the shoe, service, with the exception that it carries two (2) full length leather soles and has the forepart hob-riveted and the heel is all leather and either hob-riveted or steel rimmed. This shoe is issued on special requisition only.

SHOES, SERVICE, REVERSE UPPERS, COMPOSITION SOLE Stock No. 72-S-2350-20-72-S-2356-51

This shoe is made with flesh out upper leather and synthetic rubber sole and heel. The shoe has no toe cap. The issue of this shoe is reserved for overseas use and should not be issued in this country.

SHOES, SAFETY, COMPOSITION SOLE Stock No. 72-S-1553-18-72-S-1563-32

This shoe is similar to shoes, service, reversed uppers, composition sole, except that it has a steel box toe and a neoprene oil-resistant sole and heel. The principal users of this item are Port Battalions.

A dress type of oxford now provided principally to the Medical Corps. It is not distributed to the regular Enlisted Men.

BOOTS, LEATHER, LACED, LEGGING-TOP

This is a boot used by the Cavalry. It is made of welt construction 17 inches high, blucher pattern with wrap legging top, three (3) straps, $\frac{1}{2}$ bellows tongue, full toe blucher vamp, toe cap (no box), unlined, leather sole with slip tap and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) rubber heel. The upper is cut from the best quality, heavy weight, chrome tanned, dress elk side, Army Russet shade.

BOOTS, SKI-MOUNTAIN, WITH RUBBER CLEATED SOLE Stock No. 72-B-2846-10-72-B-2850-14

This boot has superseded boots, ski-mountain, and boots, ski-mountain with tricouni nails. It is similar except that it has a rubber cleated sole in place of a plain leather sole or leather sole with nails. This boot makes no noise and does not cause sparks as the nailed boot sometimes does; wears better and are warmer and lighter. This boot requires the wearing of one pair of socks, wool, cushion sole; two pairs of socks, wool, ski; and one pair of insoles.

A combination boot intended for both skiing and mountain climbing. It is constructed on a last having a rocker bottom in order to facilitate walking or climbing, and the square toes and grooved heels are designed to fit ski bindings. One pair of socks, wool, cushion sole; two pairs of socks, wool, ski; and one pair of insoles are worn with this boot. WT: 7.00 lbs per pr.

INSOLES, FELT, BLOCKER TYPE

Stock No. 72-1-425

These are felt insoles for replacement to be cut by the men in the field to the shape required. The insole is used for insulation and to absorb moisture. It is kept in the boot or shoe only when actually being used. As soon as the footwear is taken off it must be removed and dried. WT- 20 1hs

CREEPERS, ICE

Stock No. 74-C-311

An adjustable, short spiked plate which is attached by straps and buckles to the sole of the shoe and used to give secure footing where icy conditions prevail (used chiefly around airports). May be worn with any type of shoe except nailed or rubber cleated ski-mountain boots, which grip adequately on average ice and snow.

PROTECTORS, SOLE, SKI-BOOT

A metal protector, screwed and nailed to the edge of the sole of the boot, ski-mountain, where they will be in contact with the side of the bindings, ski, to prevent the leather from softening and wearing at the points of contact.

These boots are highly greased and are not intended for use in extreme cold. Although they are relatively waterproof, because of the double vamp construction, they do soak through when exposed to wet conditions for long periods of time. Once wet, they are very difficult to dry. These boots should therefore be used only in moderate weather, neither too wet or too cold. Boots, blucher, high top, are designed to be worn with a pair of insoles, one pair of cushion-sole socks and one pair of wool ski socks.



This shoe replaces shoe pac, 12 inch, and is similar to it except that it has a full $\frac{1}{8}$ inch heel, a steel shank, a more waterproof seam between the leather and rubber and a fuller last so as to more comfortably accommodate two pairs of ski socks and one pair of felt insoles. It is supplied in three widths so as to provide a better fit. This shoe is issued in the same size tariff as other ordinary shoes. It has been designed for wear over two pairs of wool socks without necessity for issuing it in a larger size.

This is the warmest type of footwear issued and is used in extremely cold climates. It has a bottom made of dry tanned kidskin or buckskin and a fabric top. The boot is permeable, allowing perspiration of the feet to evaporate rather than confining it within the boot, causing freezing of the feet. These boots are worn with two pairs of insoles, felt; one pair of socks, wool, cushion sole; two pairs of socks, wool, ski, and one pair of socks, felt. Its principal value is that it is roomy, allowing the use of many pairs of socks without constricting the foot. As it is not waterproof it cannot be used in weather warmer than 20° F. or in wet snow.

Boot, Arctic, felt, is a lightweight boot approximately $10\frac{1}{2}$ inches high. The boot laces up to above the ankle and a 5-inch cuff with two buckles is attached to the top of the quarters similar to the combat boot. The proper sock combination to be worn inside the boot is as follows: 1 pr. felt insoles, 1 pr. socks wool cushion sole, 2 pr. socks wool ski.

The upper part of the boot is made of white felt which provides camouflage in snowy areas. The sole is made of the best grade felt to provide warmth, adequate traction and durability. The heel is made with a leather base and rubber top lift. This boot supersedes shoes, Arctic, felt; shoes, felt, cold climate, and overshoes, Arctic, cold climate.





BOOTS, COMBAT, TROPICAL Stock No. 72-B-134-184--72-B-134-469

Boots, combat, tropical, give adequate protection and support to the wearer's ankle and foot; provide good fit and comfort under conditions of terrain encountered in tropical areas; and provide against entry of mud, sand, and insects to the full height of the boot. This boot supersedes the boot, jungle, cotton.

This is an all rubber, five buckle shoe worn over regular shoes and used by the Amphibious Forces. The sole is so constructed that it grips well on slippery surfaces.

The waders reach up under the arm pits and across the chest and back and fits reasonably tight to effect a fairly good water seal. The wader is put on over the service shoe, as its title indicates, and is worn by a man unloading boats when establishing a beach head or in deep water construction work.






Fig. 1-Adaptors, ski, are a set of aluminum blocks.
