

(11) Demolition kits. For the removal of obstacles to landing on advanced landing fields and glider landing zones. May also be used for the destruction of electronic and visual aids if capture is imminent or abandoned.

(13) Machete. Used for clearing vegetation to improve visibility of field markings, provide cleared radiation patterns for electronic aids,

between chief sketcher and assistants when surveying airfields. Provides communication between team members, team leader, and security personnel after installation of aids.

such that each team member is issued the equipment that he will install and operate during the accomplishment of the assigned mission or missions.

b. Night operations. Organization and allotment of equipment is shown in chart form by Fig. 12. If it is anticipated the team must also operate during daylight additional equipment must be carried.

ND TRANSPORTATION.

a. Commander. It is the responsibility of the senior commander of an operation to provide the equipment and transportation necessary to the

commander as to the equipment and transportation requirements immediately upon receipt of the warning order or operations order.
