If you need medical or hospital care, it should be reported at once to the nearest Navy activity. Generally, it will be the Navy Recruiting Station. You should do this in person, but if unable to do so, another person can make the report. If necessary, however, you may report to any military hospital (Navy, Army, Marine, Veterans' Administration). If admitted, you will be treated without expense to yourself. If military medical care is not available, the Navy will be responsible for civilian medical attention only when it has been arranged by a Navy representative having the power to do so. Therefore, it is highly important in all cases to report to the nearest Navy activity as quickly as possible.
