

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF THE RATING SCALE
FOR CANDIDATES FOR OFFICER TRAINING SCHOOLS

1. The statements listed below describe ways of reacting which are important in estimating a candidate's chances of becoming a successful officer.

You are asked to read each statement carefully, and to consider in it relation to the candidate. Then,

Encircle Yes if in general the statement fairly describes the candidate,

Encircle No if in general the statement does not describe the candidate,

Encircle ? if the statement cannot be answered yes or no with respect to the candidate.

Be sure that each of the statements is marked by encircling one of the three alternatives. Do not leave any of the statements unmarked.

After each of the specific statements have been marked, rate the candidate with respect to his "General Fitness" for attending the Officer Training Schools. Record this rating by placing a check mark (✓) on the scale at the point which best describes your recommendation. You may place your check mark at any point along the horizontal line.

Under "General remarks", enter any further statement concerning the candidate's personal fitness or any instances which support your judgement.

2. This completed signed form will accompany each Officer Candidate Application forwarded. The form will be completed and signed by the Company Commander or other Officer having close supervision of the applicant.
